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Spay/Neuter Application

*We are a subsidized spay/neuter program designed to help **low income** pet owners and animal caretakers. Please consider your own financial need before applying for our services.*

Your cat should...

- Be between 3 months and 7 years of age.
- Weigh at least 3 lbs.
- Have no known illness, injury, or medical conditions.
- Not be a brachycephalic (smoosh-faced) breed of cat

Your dog should...

- Be between 4 months and 7 years of age.
- Weigh more than 5 lbs. and less than 60 lbs. if female and less than 80 lbs. if male
- Have no known illness, injury, or medical conditions.
- Not be aggressive toward people or highly aggressive toward other animals.
- Not be a brachycephalic (smoosh-faced) breed of dog.

You should...

- Schedule an appointment.
- Bring proof of current vaccinations and testing to your appointment to receive a waiver from required services☼.
- Bring a copy of all medical records to your appointment if your pet is 5 years of age or older.
- Keep pet indoors after 8 pm on the evening prior to surgery.
- Withhold food after **midnight** the night before surgery.
- Bring each cat in an individual, labeled, clean carrier with a clean towel
- Bring dogs on a leash.
- Drop-off between 8:00 - 8:30 am. If you are late, late fees will apply.
- Leave your pet in the car until you have completed all of the paperwork required during the drop-off. Drop-off takes about 15-20 minutes.
- Pay for services during the morning drop-off with cash, check, or credit card (MC, Visa, or Discover).
- Pick up at 3:00 pm. If you are late, late fees will apply.
- If you need to cancel, please call at least 24 hours prior to your appointment.
