Transfer Out Agreement- to be signed upon pick-up

Receiving party agrees that the Baltimore Humane Society is making no representations or warranties about the condition, personality or temperament of the animal and that they will be responsible for assessing the animal’s behavior and/or temperament prior to disposition. Receiving party understands that the transferred animal only received the medical care indicated on the Baltimore Humane Society medical record. All sexually intact animals must be altered by the Receiving party prior to adoption, unless medically contra-indicated. Receiving party will care for the animal while in their possession, and screen potential adopters through their normal adoption standards set forth by Receiving party. Receiving party will notify the Baltimore Humane Society if the animal is determined to be unadoptable and if the animal is a candidate for euthanized. The Receiving party promises and agrees to be solely responsible for this animal and to indemnify and hold harmless the Baltimore Humane Society, Baltimore Humane Society Representatives, Staff and Volunteers from any and all claims of liability for the conduct of this animal on or after the date of this transfer and agreement of contract.
