Details Below...

- Approximately 45 minutes to 1 hour in duration
- BYO Dog (Proof of rabies vaccination required)
- Rain or Shine
- \$2 per dog participation fee required
- Moderate to advanced hiking level, so dog and hiker need to be relatively fit and able to maneuver down trees, climb hills, and cross streams
- All dogs must be on a 4-6 foot leash (no retractable leashes permitted) and walked by a hiker that is 14 years of age or older (only 1 dog per person)
- Bring plenty of drinking water for yourself and your dog
- Appropriate hiking attire is recommended – comfortable, flexible, closed-toe shoes and durable clothing that can withstand mud, tall grass, twigs, stickers, stream water, etc.
